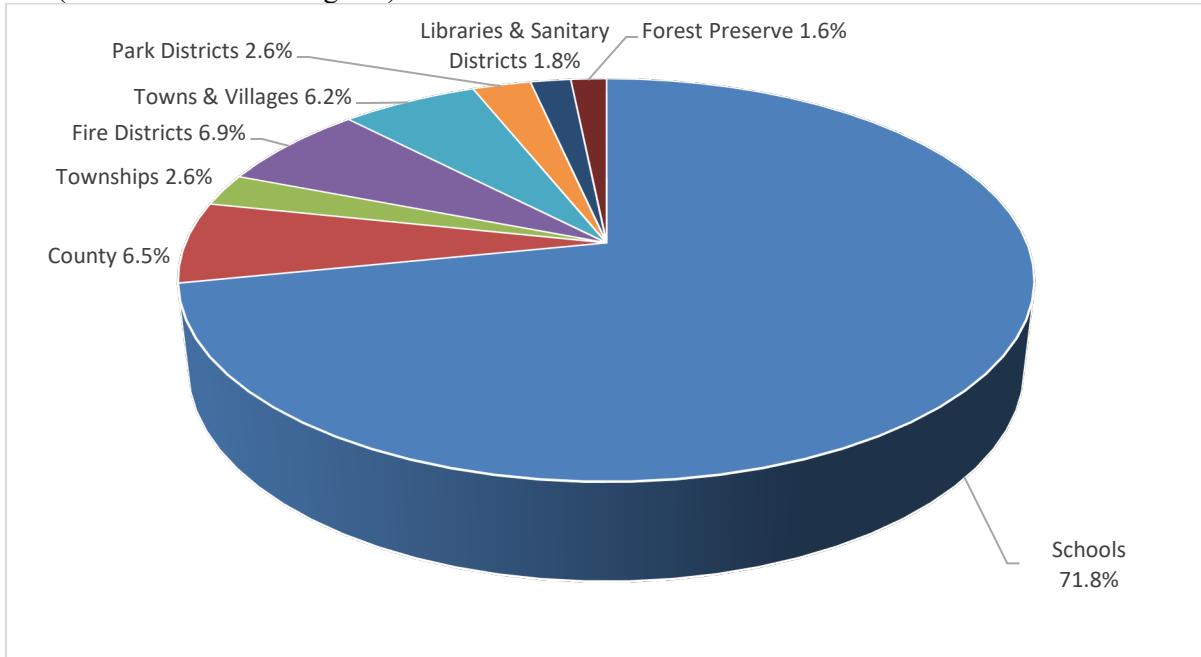


HOW YOUR REAL ESTATE TAX DOLLAR IS DISTRIBUTED

This chart below displays how the real estate dollar is spent on the **average** over the entire county. Your individual tax bill percentages may vary slightly due to differences in the make-up of the taxing districts in your area. For example, properties located in the unincorporated areas do not have a village or town tax. (%’s are 2024 actual figures)



As illustrated above, 6.5% of your real estate dollar goes to Kendall County Government. On a home with a \$3000 tax bill, this amounts to approximately \$195.
